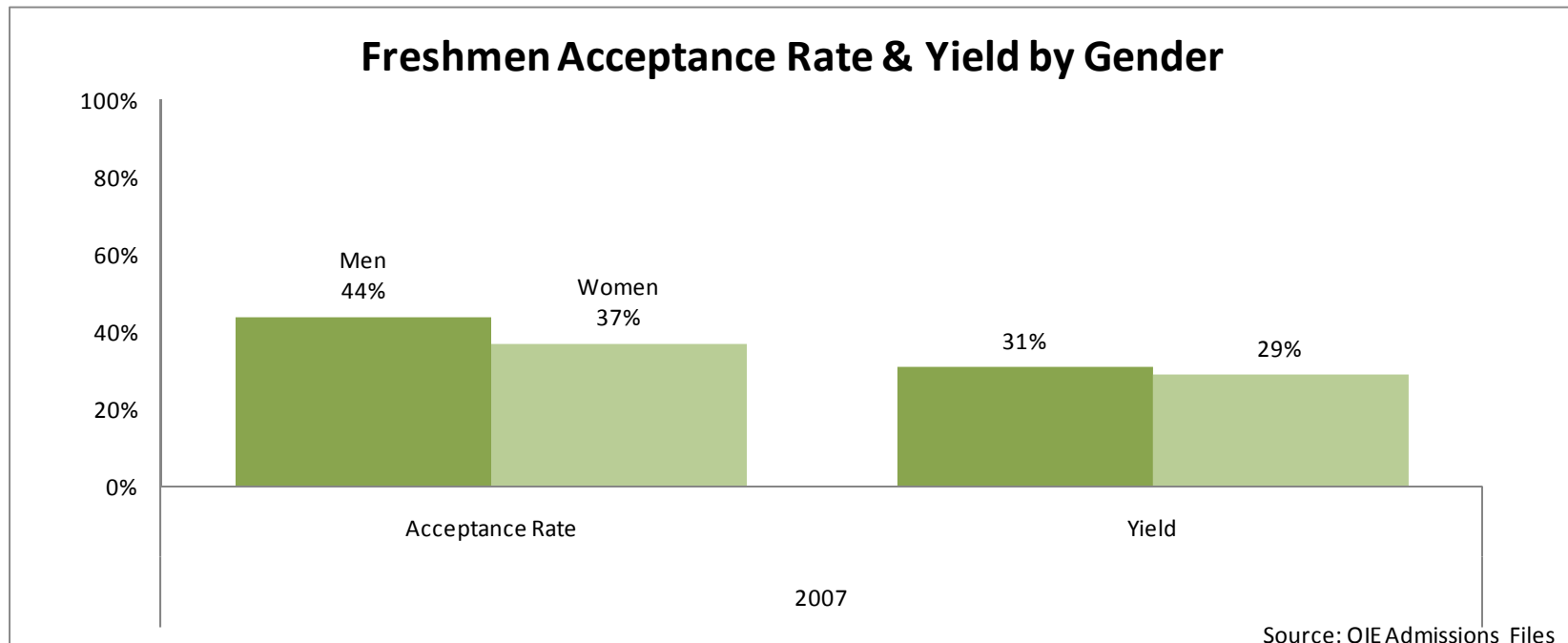

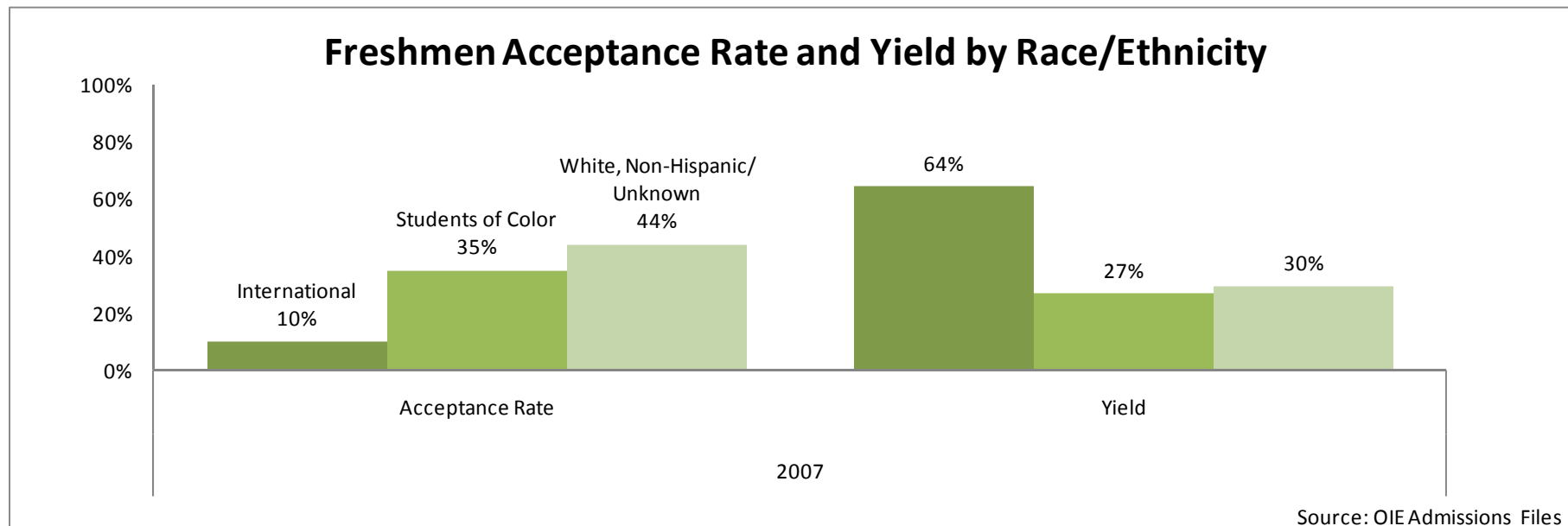

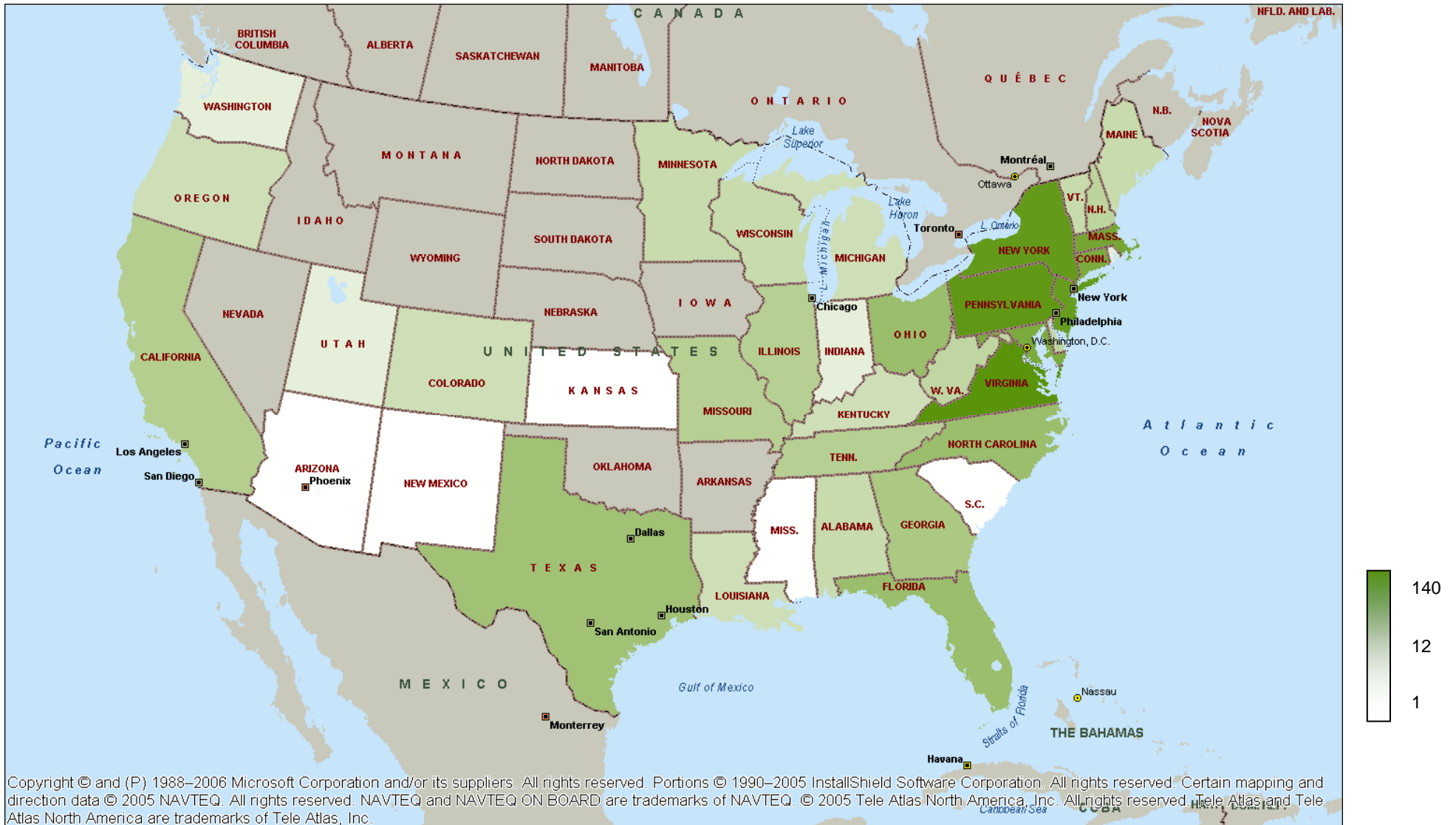

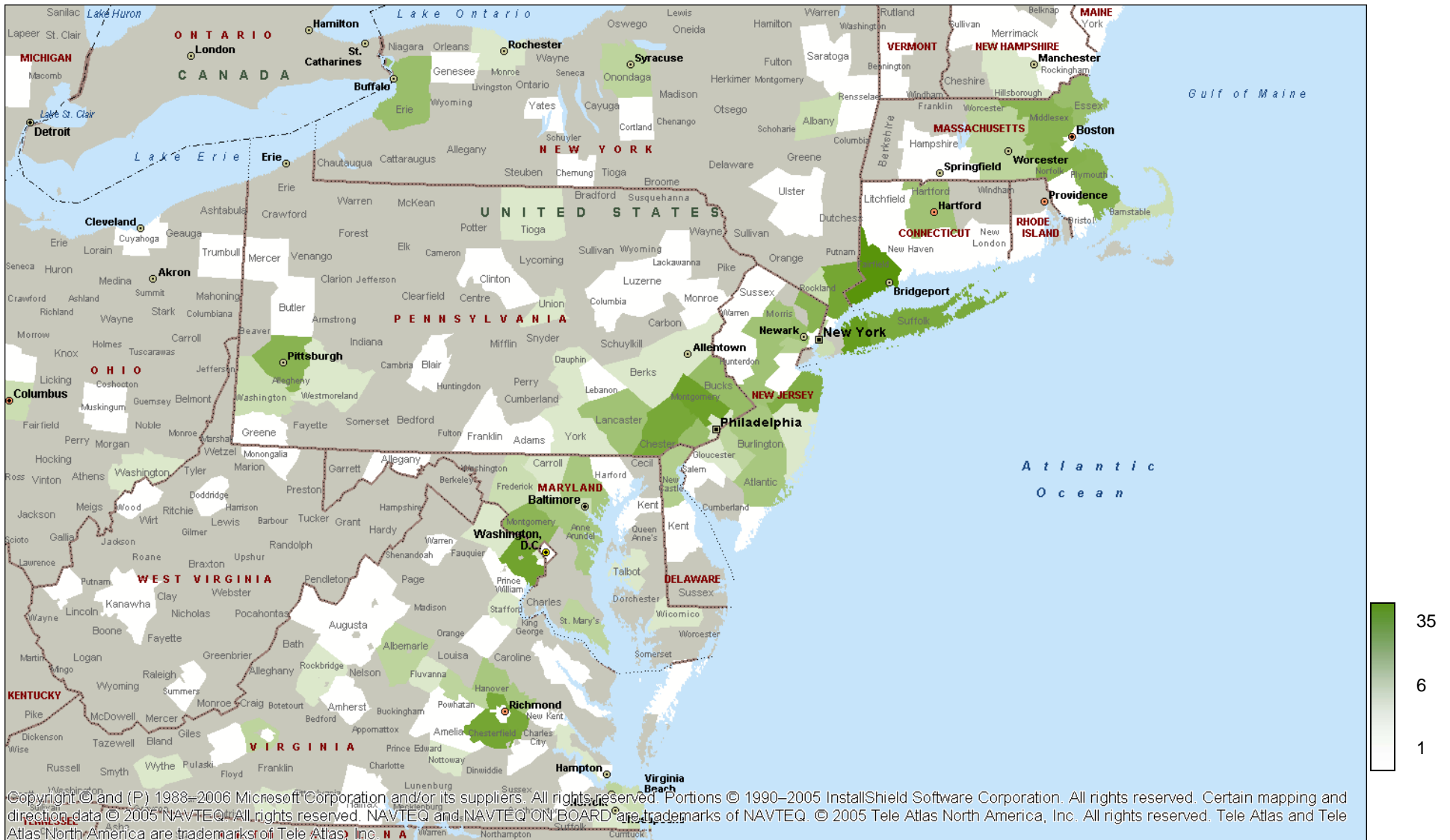

## Freshmen in High Concentration Areas by County

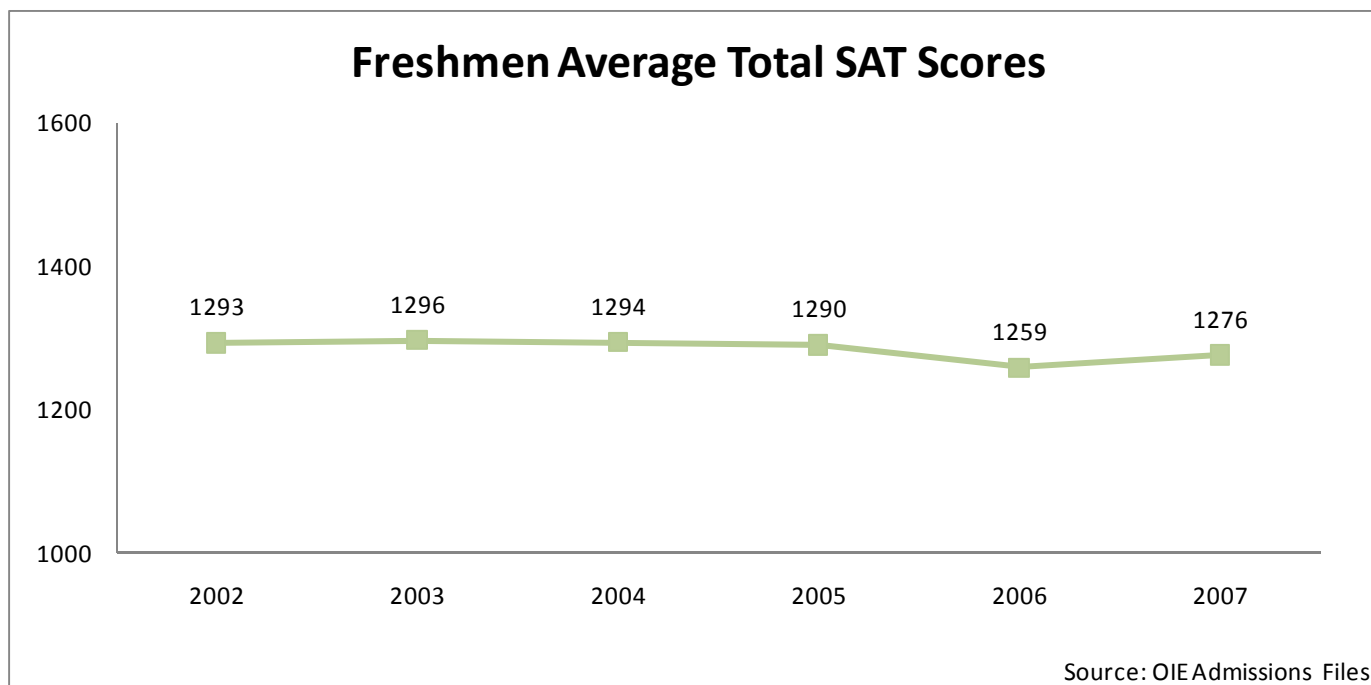

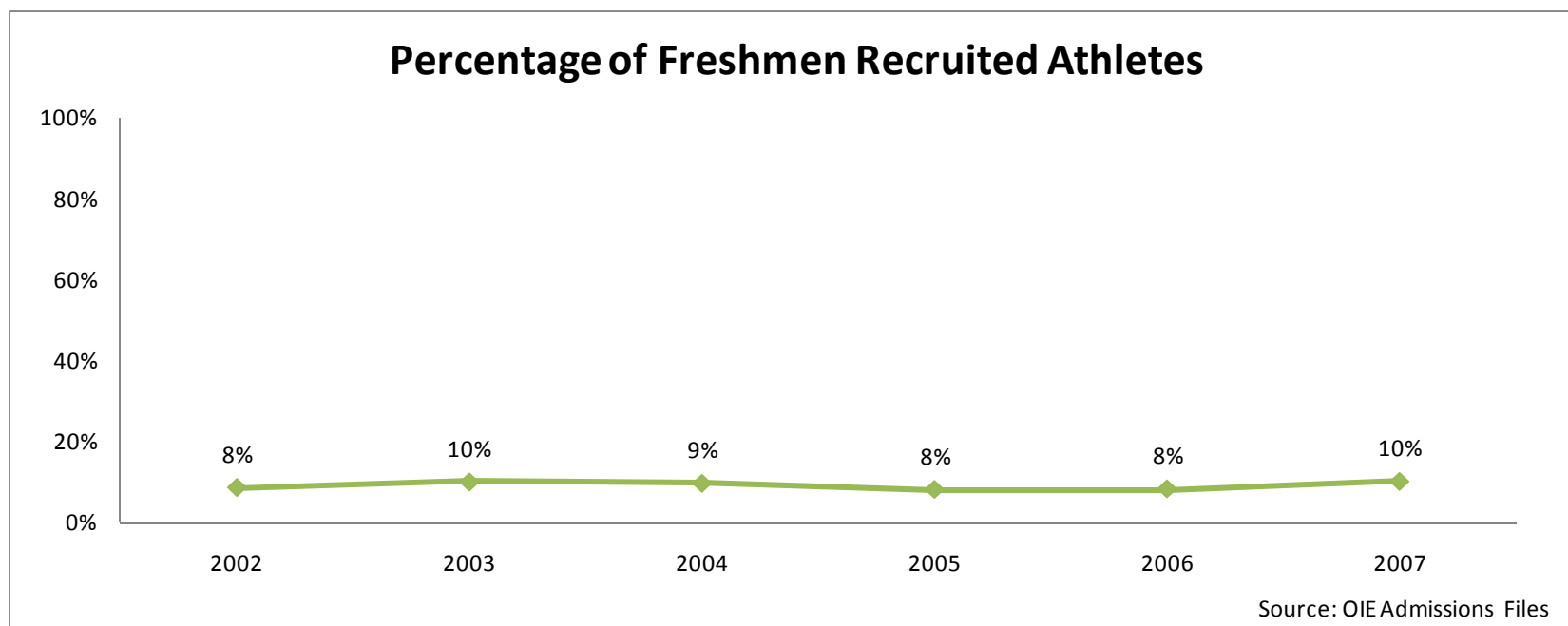
