Survey Administration Period: March 19-May 20, 2024 Response Rate: 33% (252 responded/770 invited)

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The University of Richmond Senior Exit Survey was administered online from March 19 through May 20, 2024, to seniors who graduated from the Schools of Arts & Sciences, Business, and Jepson (December 2023, May 2024, and August 2024). The purpose of the survey is to gain insight into students' satisfaction with their college experience. Of the 770 students invited to participate in the online survey, 252 responded, resulting in a 33% response rate.
